As a charity seeking donations from the public we Safe Ireland National Social Change Agency CLG trading as Safe Ireland aim to comply with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public.

- Safe Ireland is committed to complying with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public and has formally discussed and adopted the Guidelines at a meeting of the governing body.

- Safe Ireland has appointed the CEO to be responsible for compliance with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public.
- Safe Ireland has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and Board of Directors. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- Safe Ireland prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 and the Charities Regulator which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- Safe Ireland ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
- Safe Ireland is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
